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Subject: Establishing an association

Introduction:

The lesson plan provides basic information about the process of setting up associations and bodies involved in this process. Participants will learn what associations may be established. They will have the opportunity to familiarize themselves with governing rules of both the ordinary and registered associations, and thus to compare these two types of associations and to determine in practice why the ordinary association are usually the easiest form of associations.

Participants will learn about the rules regarding the work in an association (including joining the association and resigning from it). They will find out more about the kinds of registered associations bodies and their responsibilities. Participants will be presented the basic functions of the documents governing the operation of associations. In the form of exercise they will be able to see some of them on specific examples, to verify the knowledge acquired during the classes.

The aims:

Students/Participants will:

- understand what the association is and what are the kinds of association;
- familiarize with the regulations concerning the associations, particularly those relating to their establishment.

Problems to be discussed:

1. What is the association?
2. The kinds of associations.
3. Establishing associations and membership.
4. Exercise with the use of simple association rules (Appendix No 1).
5. Law – The Act on Associations.



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Methods and Forms:

Lecture supported by multimedia Microsoft PowerPoint presentation, questions, working with text
